### TARDY POLICY

Be in the class, in your assigned seat, with appropriate class materials, when class starts.

### HALL PASS POLICY

**Mrs. Green's Hall Pass - Bathroom Pass**

\*12 Passes Per YEAR (6 per semester)

\*Students may use them during INDEPENDENT WORK/STUDIO time ONLY.

\*No students leave my classroom during the first or last 10 minutes of class.

All students must be in the classroom during this time unless requested by the office or another teacher.

### What about....?

-Lost/used up before the end of the Semester? = Oh well.

-Late to class without a pass? = Cannot use a Pass that day

-Each left over pass? = 1 Daily Project Progress Point



### CELL PHONE POLICY

(INCLUDES ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES & COMPUTERS)

Cell phone usage in this class will not be tolerated, UNLESS it is directly related to the current art assignment AND you have teacher permission. There will be ONE verbal warning given prior to disciplinary action. Review the student handbook for more details on cell phone and electronic device policies.



All cell phones should be OFF and in your backpack BEHIND Mrs. Green's desk starting at the very beginning of class.

I understand that if I use my Cell Phone in class for something other than my art assignment and/or without getting permission first, Mrs. Green will take it away from me.

A positive learning environment depends on thoughtful questions, active participation, mutual respect and a consistent best effort from all students and the teacher. Students are expected to work cooperatively, which includes meaningful interactions with peers and the teacher.

### EXTRA CREDIT

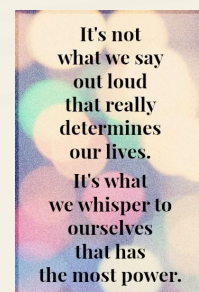
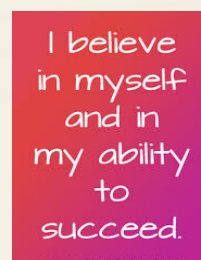
Extra Credit: There is no extra credit to raise your grade. All students are to go back and redo the project/assignment until they have met the high standard of excellence.

# "STUDIO WORK" DAYS

## ANNOUNCEMENTS, ATTENDANCE, & ASSIGNED SEATS

Come into class QUIETLY, put all of your bags or anything thing you have with you behind Mrs. Green's desk, take your pencil with you and sit in your assigned seat, listen for any class Announcements, wait for Attendance to be taken

## BREATHE & CENTER – SET YOUR GOAL FOR THE DAY (CLASS) & PLAN

Students: Once seated, deep breathe and listen to the music (couple mins); Students: THEN - set an art (work) goal for the class and plan out how you will achieve your goal and what you plan to accomplish for the project during that class period. Fill out your "Workflow Checklist and Goal Setting " sheet.

## INSTRUCTION & DIRECTIONS

Eyes Open, Mouths Closed; Pay attention, any new directions introduced, lesson concepts and/or procedures reviewed. The student in the RED CHAIR - 1 per table color - is the only one allowed to get up and get the supplies for the table.

## INDEPENDENT WORK TIME

RED CHAIR: One (1) person from each table gets your table's brown folder. Get your portfolio from the table folder. Remove all papers from your portfolio and/or binder you need for working on your current project (including: directions, rubrics, handouts, and current work). DURING THIS TIME IS THE ONLY TIME YOU MAY USE YOUR HALL PASS (as long as all other hall pass procedures have been followed).

## PEER FEEDBACK – 2 PEER CRITIQUE TIMES

The class will be stopped once or twice a class period to provide each other with PEER FEEDBACK on how the current work is going. Peer Feedback is a part of your overall grade. The student talking: You must give clear, specific suggestions about the other student's work. Telling the other student what areas of their work they have done good on and what areas of their work still need refinement and how to improve upon it. The student listening: Take notes on the Peer Feedback Form so you may refer back to the suggestions later on. These Peer Critiques will occur once or twice a class period.

## CLEANUP

Put away all supplies. Return portfolios to brown folders. Return brown folders to your class' box. Return binders back to your class shelf. Clean Up the classroom: all supplies put away, tables & counters - cleaned & dried, and floors - garbage is picked up and put in the trash cans, supplies picked up and put away

## BACKPACKS & TICKET-OUT-THE-DOOR

Students: finish filling out the rest of your "Workflow Checklist & Goal Setting" sheet(s). When the entire table is ready and the tap light is on\*, the teacher will tell the students to go get their backpacks (and other things) from behind the teacher's desk. Students must then return to their seats. Tap light is turned off! The teacher dismisses the class, students push in your chairs and hand any completed paper(s) to the teacher as you leave the class for the day.

Students - Keep in mind during the work time what your art goal for the day is and what you want to achieve on your artwork. This way you are making EXCELLENT progress on your assigned project. Ask your table group members for suggestions and/or ideas... that is what they are there for. Ask Mrs. Green for suggestions and/or ideas... that is what she is there for. \*if the tap light is not at the table, then it obviously doesn't need to be turned on for Mrs. Green to let you get your things.

## CLASS CODE OF CONDUCT

\*\*Use of any electronic device (with permission) is the soul responsibility of the student. The teacher and/or school is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft of any electronic device that a student chooses to bring to campus.

\*\*Share class supplies willingly, appropriately, and with extreme care. HAND supplies to each other!

\*\*Take excellent care of ALL class supplies. The throwing of ANY supplies and/or trash will NOT be tolerated and privileges will be lost.

\*\*All artwork must be original and created at the time each project is assigned in order to meet the criteria and standards for that project.

\*\*Keep all fidget toys packed away, out of sight, in your backpack and FAR AWAY from your artwork.

\*\*Follow the dress code.

\*\*Only WATER in a closed container is allowed in class.

\*\*Stay in your Assigned Seat during the entire duration of class. Only if given permission FIRST is a student allowed to move seats. (Permission is only granted on the VERY RARE occasion. No need to ask every class period, if students are allowed to move seats, the teacher will announce it at the beginning of class.)

\*\*You must get permission from the teacher AND use your hall/bathroom pass in order to leave the class at anytime. Use them wisely!! When you're out, you're out.

\*\*Return to the classroom quickly and quietly when out on a pass. (No more than 3 mins out of class. Need more time? You can get a pass to the nurse instead.)

\*\*Inappropriate behavior, language, drawings, and/or disrespectful attitudes will NOT be tolerated; This also includes any showing of bullying behavior, rude, and/or ignorant actions/comments towards anyone, especially about someone's looks and/or ability. All "extra" privileges will be suspended - as well as discipline consequences.
