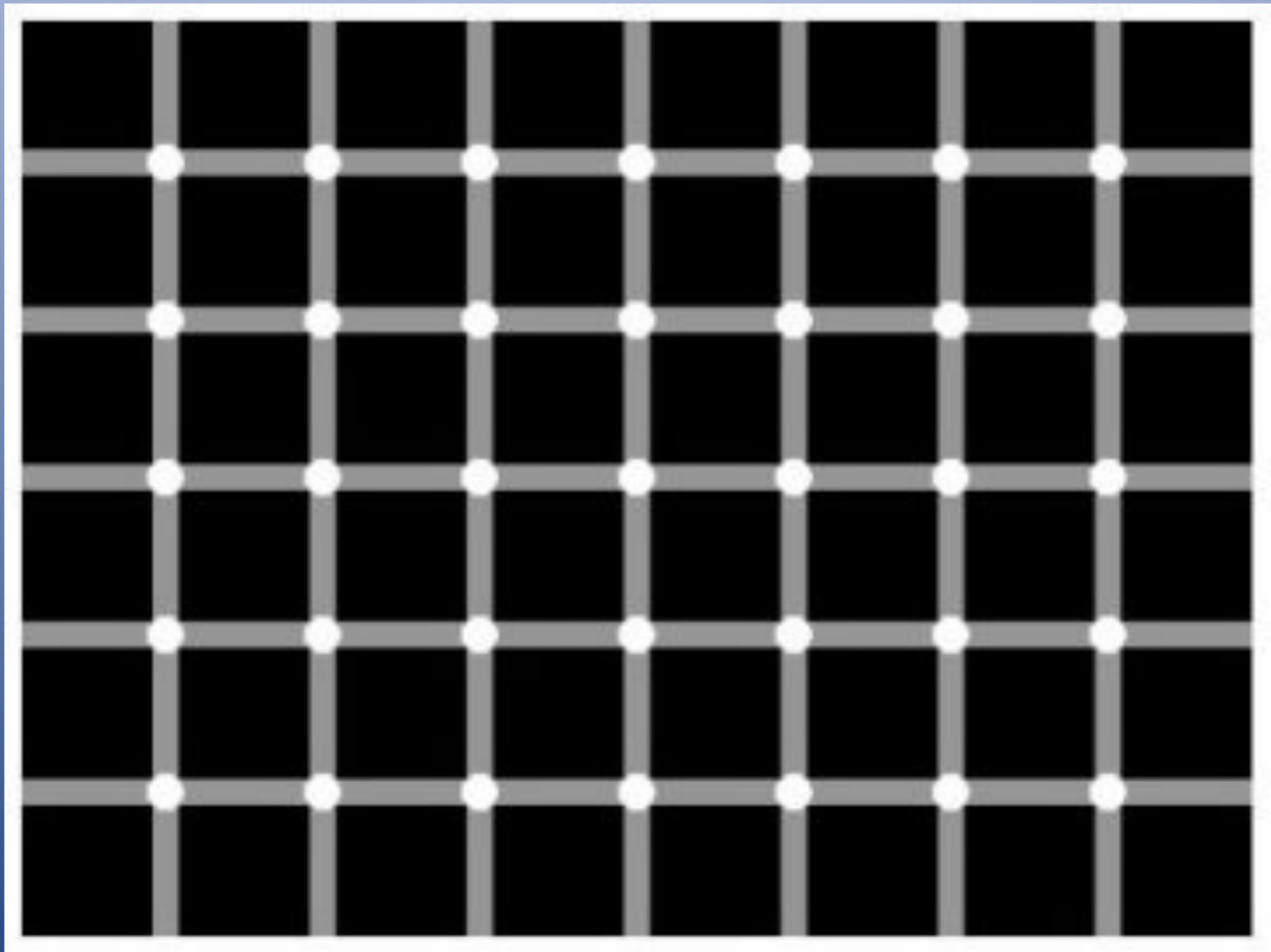


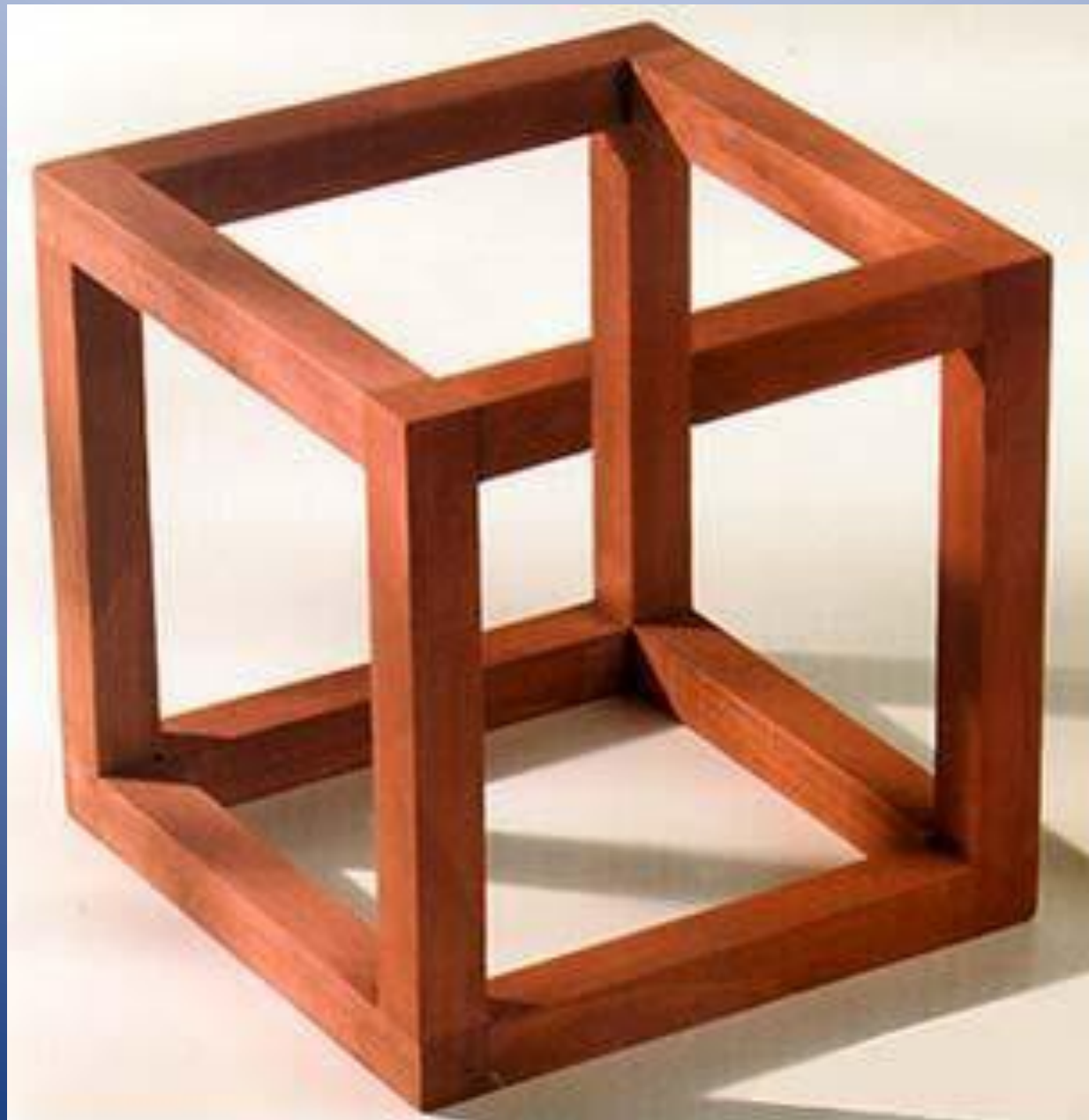


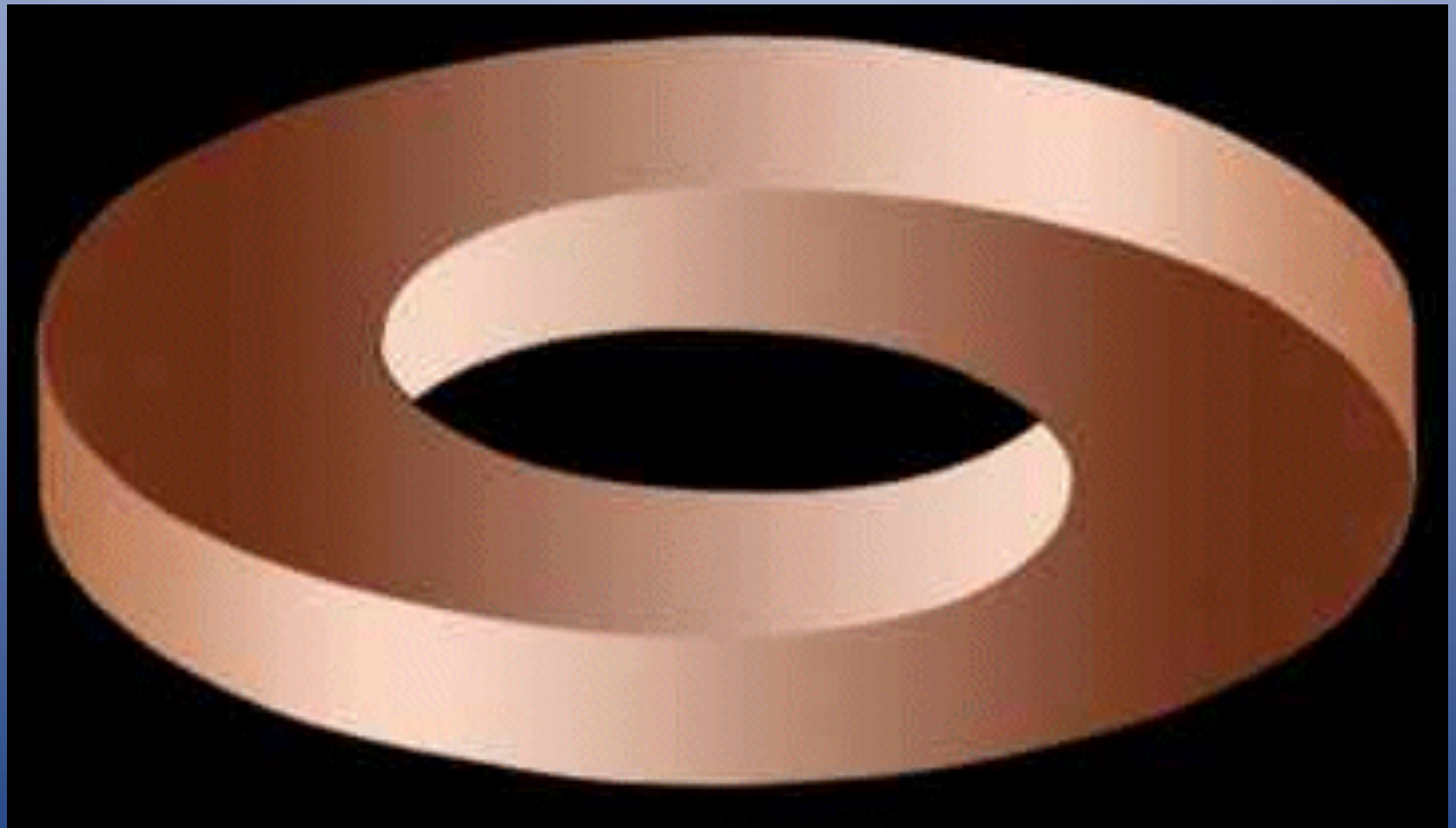


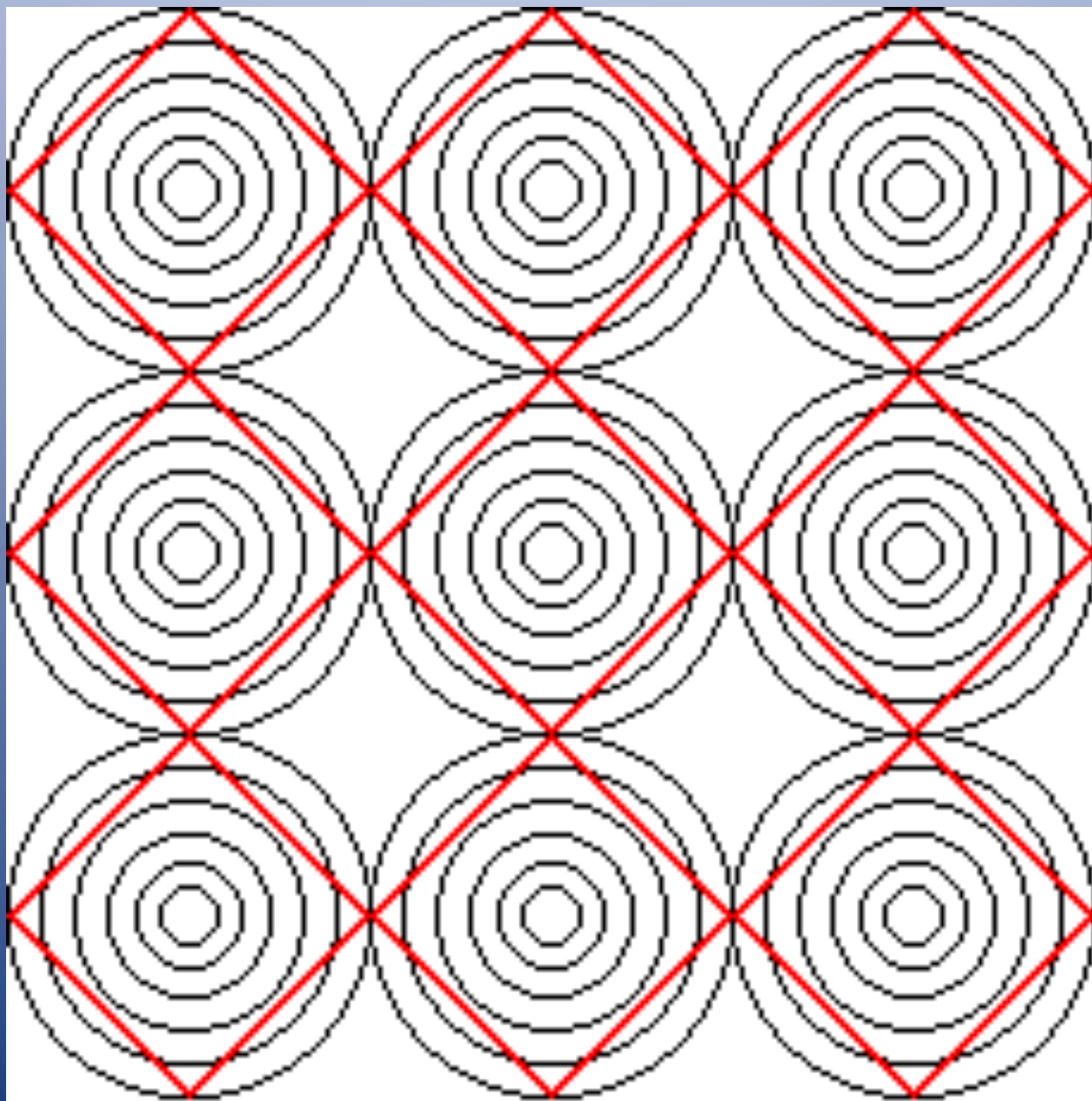


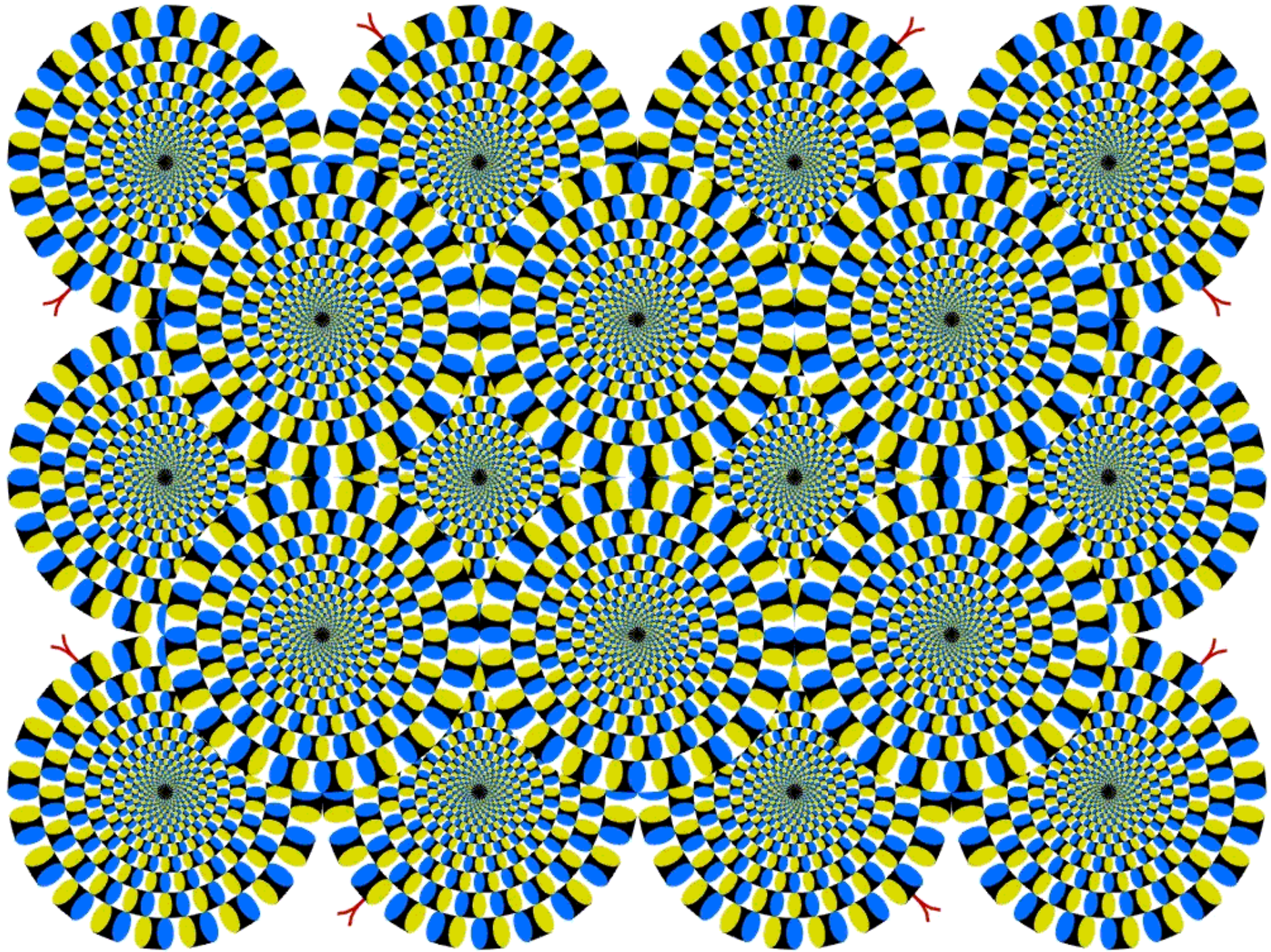








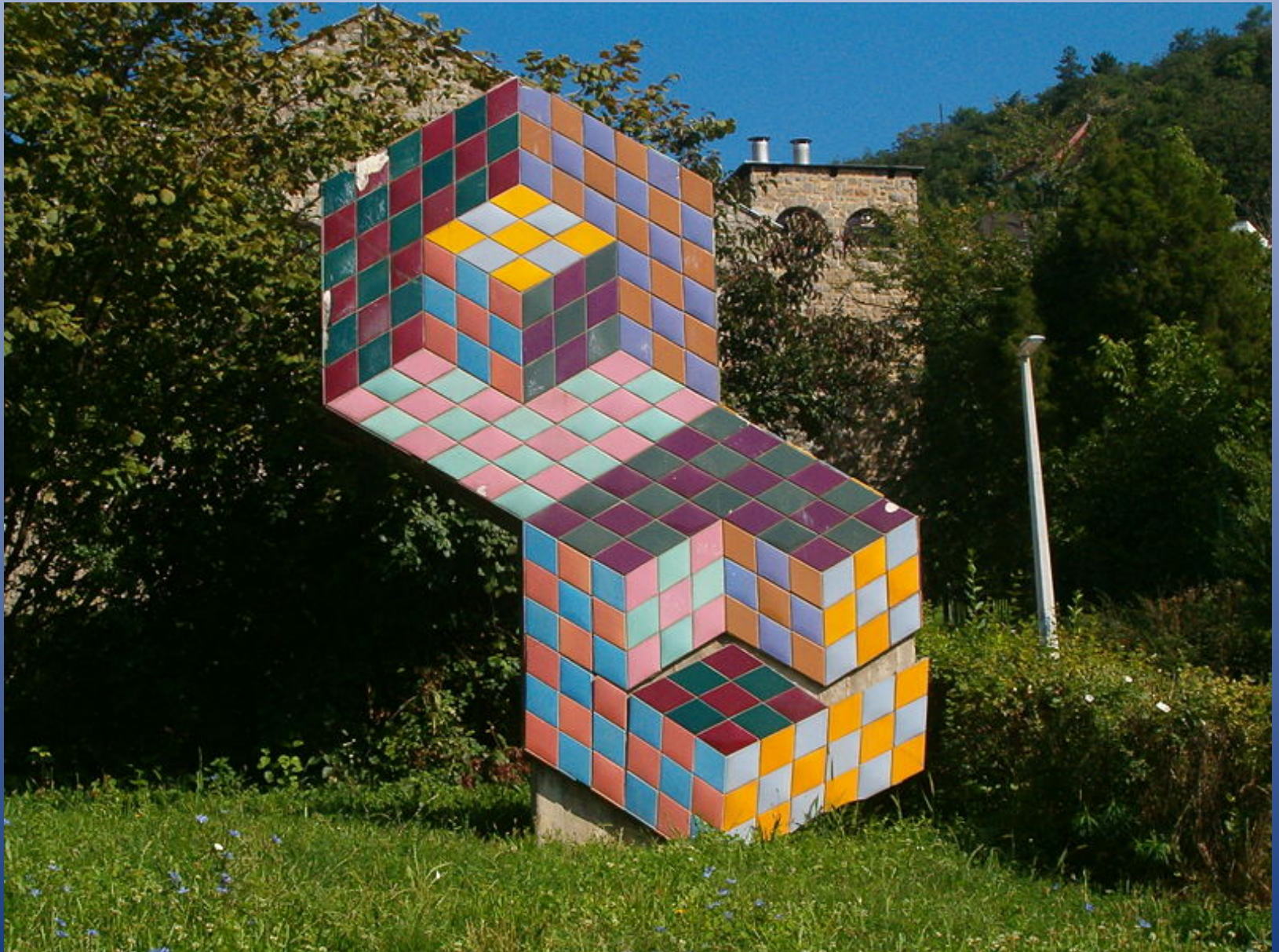




Victor Vasarely

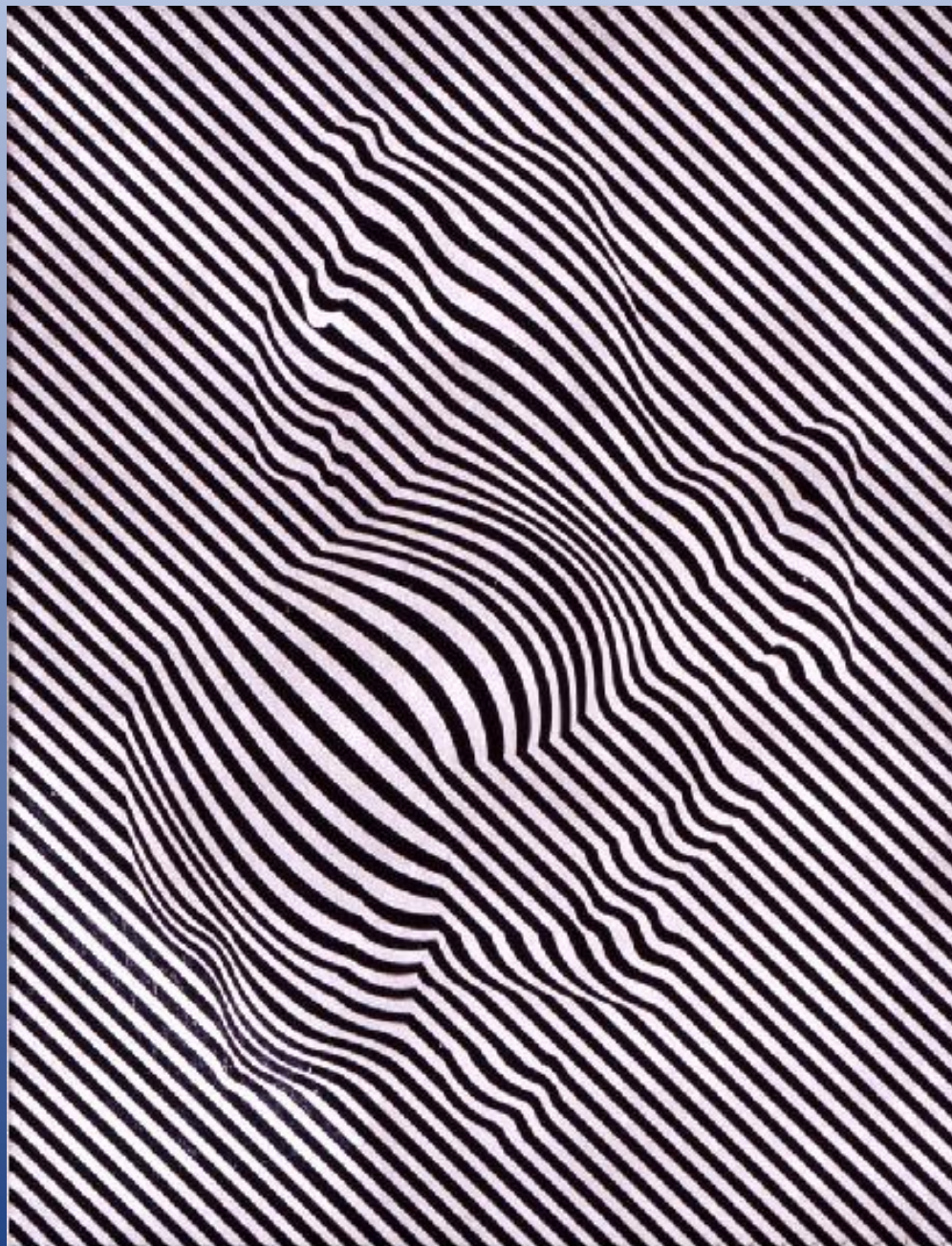
- Born in 1906 in Hungary

- He is considered the father of “op art”



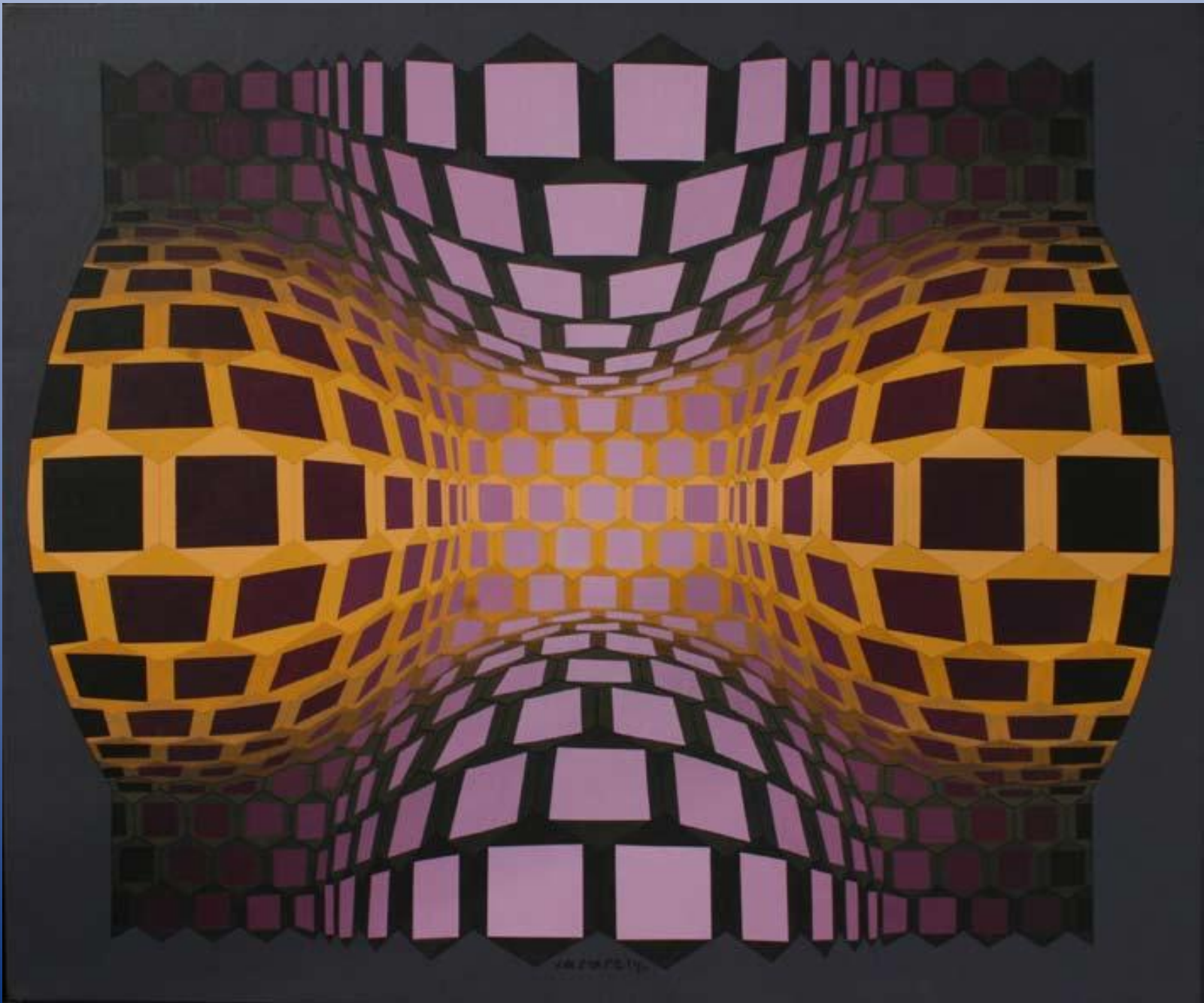


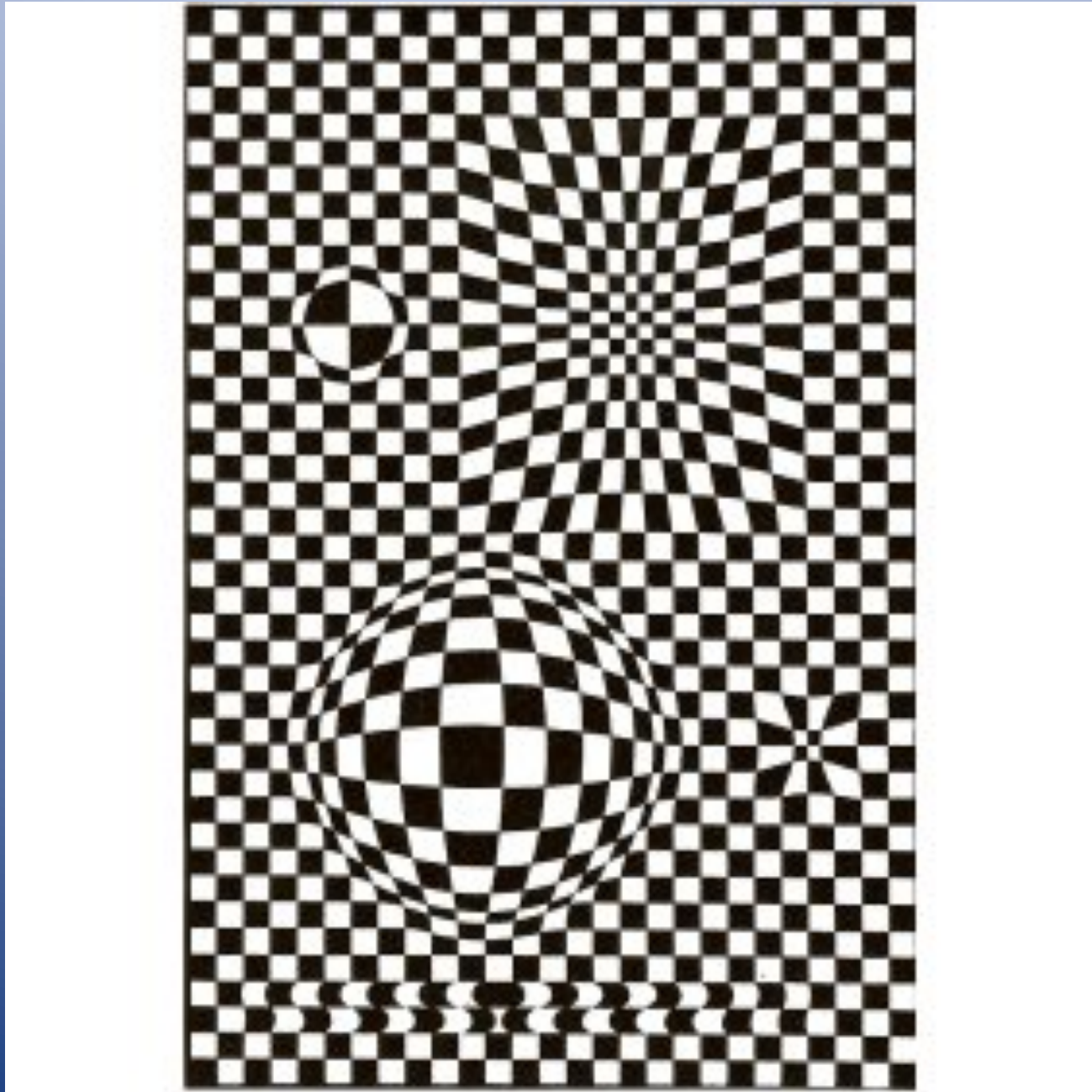

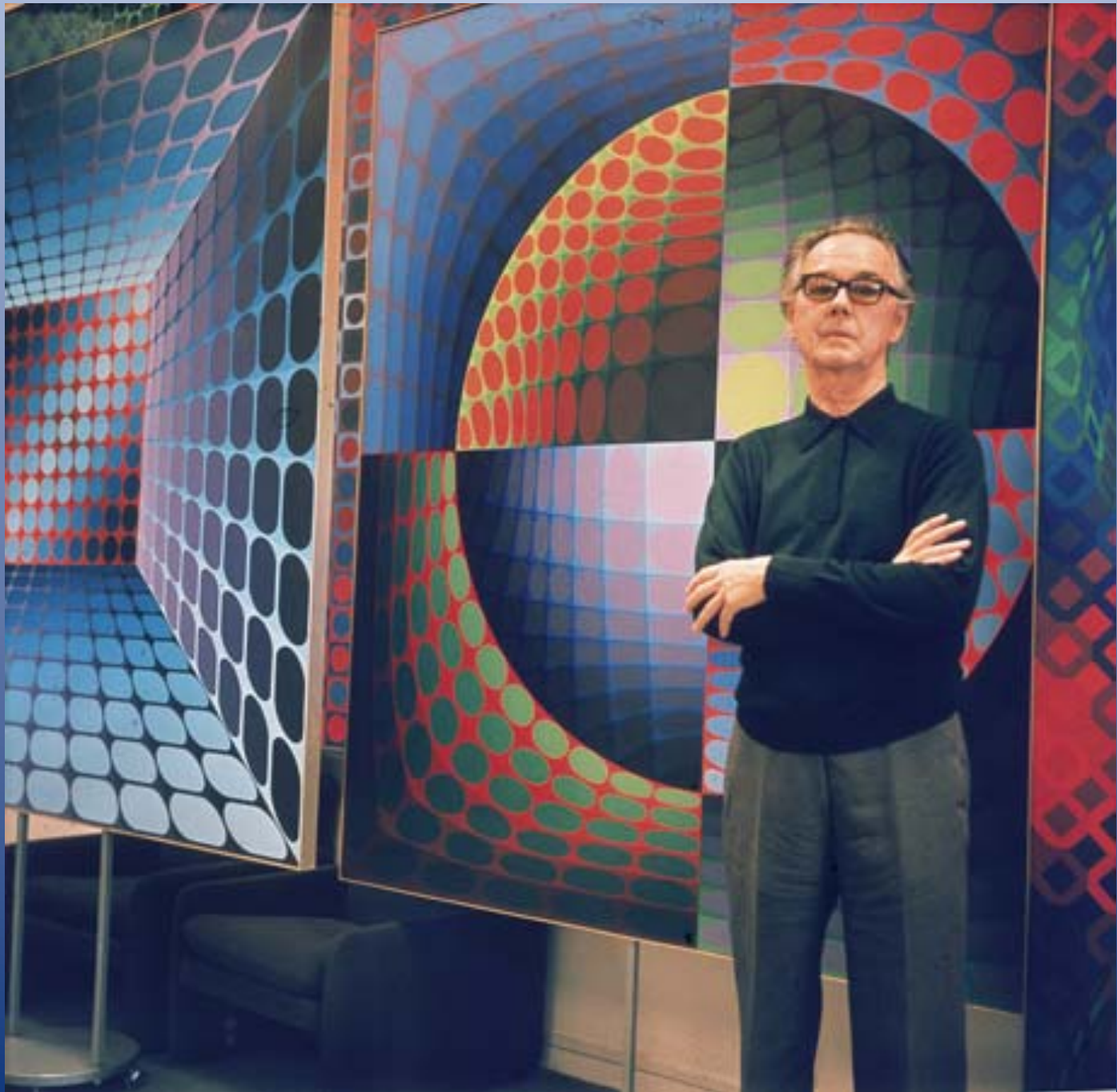
