

Photography Production Teams



Teams: Consist of 3-4 students only (3 preferably)
Initial PTs will be assigned by the teacher
PTs will change periodically throughout the year
Assigned Seats will be determined by PTs

Most/All PTs will be assigned seats with only their team

members

PT assignments: ALL members of the team MUST be involved in (contribute to) the completion of the assignment AND have all PT member names included on all PT assignments turned in.

Studio Work Time: Students will work in their PTs during the entire duration of Studio Work time

What does the PT do: Support each other with ideas, help with set-ups, are each other's models (when the assignment calls for one), holds equipment (ex: light reflectors), reviews each other's photographs, helps determine the best ones to be included on both individual and PT group assignments; these are people in class you go to for photo ideas/photo advice/help with the computers....

Code of Conduct: Cameras, camera phones, or other recording devices may not be used in restrooms, locker rooms, changing facilities or other areas where personal privacy is a reasonable expectation.

Stay on the main campus, don't enter any classrooms (whether there is a class in there or not) or other buildings without permission, stay with your PT, share the camera (if using a class camera) and help each other get good photographs, return when you hear **the signal** OR when there are **10 minutes** left in the period.

Always ask permission to take a non-PT member's picture. NOTHING can be posted of any individual on ANY social media site without their approval (with witnesses to verify).

Inappropriate behavior or images will NOT be tolerated; your trust will be lost and all picture taking privileges suspended - as well as discipline consequences.
